The Mie Board of Education is currently preparing for the April 2025 grand opening of Yotsubagasaki Prefectural Junior High School, a diversified learning school and evening school. This survey will help us assess how many people in the Hokusei region would be interested in attending such a school, and whether such a school is needed in the Hokusei region.

Junior High School Night Schools are **public schools** like their daytime counterparts.

You are eligible to sign up for night school if you are **over 15 years old** by April 1st who

- was unable to attend elementary or Junior HS properly
- came from a country which does not have a Junior High School graduation equivalent

- There are no school fees.
- Classes are held five times a week.
- We study the same textbooks as daytime classes
- You can also study an elementary school curriculum and Japanese.
- The number of classes per year is about three-quarters.

An average school day

17:45	Homeroom (10 min)
17:55	1 st period (40 min)
18:40	2 nd period (40 min)
19:30	3 rd period (40 min)
20:15	4 th period (40 min)
20:55	Leave school

Grade School / Junior HS Edition →



“Diversified Learning Schools” are schools approved by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology to design programs for school avoidant students (students who are scared of or unable to attend school.)

Designed for students who are school avoidant or show signs of being school avoidant.

Diversified Learning Schools provide learning schedules and styles which are slightly different from other public schools. Students are taught the importance of learning together with classmates, while also being provided classes tailored to their individual learning styles and goals.

Example of a DLS (Junior High School)

[A Specialized Curriculum]

- ① The number of classes is limited to 4 or 5 per day, lowering the total number of class hours per year from 1015 hours to around 800 hours.
- ② Each class is 40 to 45 minutes long.

[Course Content]

- Japanese, mathematics, social studies, science, English, etc.
- A creative class combining music, art, technology and home economics.
- A social skills training course
- Interactive learning opportunities outside of school
